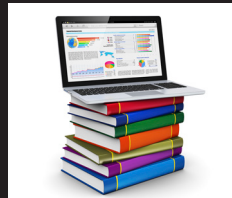
That's why Antietam Broadband and WCPS have partnered to help eligible families get:
