

BARBARA INGRAM AUDITION PROCESS

- The Audition Process has begun
- All WCPS middle schools have been visited
- Applications and packets are available on the BISFA website

Chose visit website to download Applications and packets
- Application deadline is no later than December 8th.
- Every student is guaranteed an audition for the Dance, Instrumental, Theatre, and Vocal Departments, if the application is received by the deadline. Audition dates and times will be mailed in early January.
- Creative Writers must submit their required portfolio by Dec. 10th , you will then be notified if you will be invited to the second step of the audition process.
- Visual Artists will drop off their required portfolio and written statement on either Jan. 8 - 12, you will then receive a letter informing you if you are invited to the second step of the audition process when you pick up your portfolio on Jan. 16 - 19.
- You may audition up to 2 disciplines and are encouraged to do so.
- Each year auditions become more and more competitive
- Audition dates are 3 Saturdays in January and the first 2 Saturdays in February.
- Please read the audition packets carefully and come fully prepared for your audition. Each discipline is individualized in their requirements. Vocal applicants require a separate Musical School Director Recommendation if applicable.
- Please plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to your audition time for check in.
- All auditions are closed, parents may wait in the lobby during the audition or drop their student off depending on the length of their audition. The time frame for auditions is different for each discipline and will be listed on their audition date/time letter.
- Accompanists will be provided for both the Vocal and Musical Auditions be sure to have a copy of your individual music choice for them.
- Results will be mailed in early April. If accepted the student and parent must sign the letter of commitment and return to the audition coordinator.
- All students will receive a result letter.
- If a student is placed on a waiting list, the enclosed postcard must be signed and returned, and if a position becomes available, prior to the school year, they will be contacted.
- If a student is accepted in more than one discipline, the student must then make a decision on the letter of commitment and return.
