PROGRAM AND POLICY HIGHLIGHTS

Meal Benefit Application

In an effort to better serve our families in a timely manner, we encourage you to utilize the on-line Meal Benefit Application! If you do not have access to technology, your child's school office can provide you with the paper application to complete and return to them (or the FNS office). The income guidelines change every year. Families must apply every year to requalify for benefits. To access the eligibility application, go to: www.schoollunchapp.com

MMFA (In-classroom Breakfast)

We have 21 schools who are eligible for and offer this breakfast model. Students select their meal components and eat in their classrooms when they arrive to school. Breakfast is free to all students in the following schools: Elementary- Bester, Cascade, Eastern, Emma K. Doub, Fountaindale, Funkstown, Hancock, Hickory, Lincolnshire, Marshall Street, Maugansville, Pangborn, Ruth Ann Monroe, Salem, and Williamsport. Secondary- E. Russell Hicks, Hancock Middle-High, Job Development Center, Northern Middle, Springfield Middle, and Western Heights.

After School Meals Program

Twenty-two schools are eligible for this program. After school tutoring, clubs, programs, and athletics have the opportunity to receive a meal in conjunction with their enrichment activities. Participating schools include: Elementary-Eastern, Emma K. Doub, Fountaindale, Fountain Rock, Hancock, Hickory, Jonathan Hager, Lincolnshire, Pangborn, Ruth Ann Monroe, Salem, and Williamsport. Secondary - Clear Spring, E. Russell Hicks, Hancock Middle-High, North Hagerstown High, Northern Middle, Smithsburg High, South Hagerstown High, Springfield Middle, Western Heights Middle, and Williamsport High.

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Modified MMFA (In Classroom Breakfast)

Legislation has passed that allows for high school only MMFA sites to operate a modified method of in-classroom breakfast. Students will make meal selections from the cafeteria serving lines or portable kiosks. They are still required to eat their *breakfast* in the classroom. North High, South High, and Williamsport High will start the new procedure on the first day of school.

CEP (Community Eligibility Provision) Schools

There are 11 CEP schools this school year. All students attending these schools receive a FREE breakfast and FREE lunch. Those schools are: Elementary—Bester, Eastern, Hickory, Lincolnshire, Marshall Street, Pangborn, Ruth Ann Monroe, and Salem. Secondary –Antietam Academy, Family Center, and Job Development Center.
