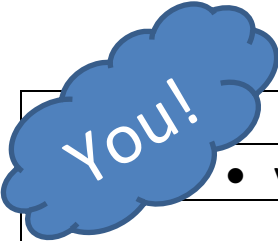


# Welcome to Washington County Public School's

• To transfer math concepts such as counting, patterns, number identification, shapes, and sorting.	• To listen and retell stories.
• To recognize some basic sight words.	• To use beginning writing skills.
• To use concepts of print to assist with reading.	• To have a greater understanding of science concepts and processes.
• To identify the 26 letters of the alphabet (lower/upercase)	• To have a greater understanding of social studies concepts and processes.
• To write his/her name with only the first letter capitalized
