**Residential Rehabilitation (RRP):** A program to support individuals with serious mental illness and co-occurring disorders to achieve maximum mental and physical health through community integration and independence in the least restrictive environment possible. House hours vary by intensity level: 40 hour per week, 24/7 both available.

**Day Program (PRP):** *Monday - Thursday: 8a-1:30p, Friday: 8a-12:30p*  
Program that consists of therapeutic groups that focus on aspects of independent living to support individuals with serious mental illness and co-occurring disorders with community integration. Meals served to clients that are enrolled in the program (breakfast/lunch).

**Community Support Program (PRP):** Program comprised of case managers that support individuals in the community with serious mental illness and co-occurring disorders to maintain and enhance their level of independence and integration in the community. Supports money management education, medication monitoring as needed, assistance with accessing somatic and mental health appointments in the community.

**Community Employment Program (CEP):** Supported employment program provides a variety of support services to assist individuals with mental illness enter employment with credible work skills. Clients supported to obtain competitive work and jobs in the community.

**Assertive Community Treatment (ACT):** Engages clients with serious mental illness and co-occurring disorders who have not benefitted from traditional office based, outpatient treatment. Multi-disciplinary team that includes a prescriber, therapists, nurses, entitlement and housing specialists, substance use counselors, and peer support.

**Homeless Outreach Program (HOP):** *Walk in Hours: Monday-Thursday: 8a-12 noon*  
Serves homeless individuals in Washington County with linkage to treatment providers for somatic and mental health services, assistance with applying for health insurance, food stamps, housing and entitlements, provisions of hygiene and clothing items (as available), and assistance obtaining birth certificates, ID cards and social security cards.

**Outpatient Mental Health Clinic (OMHC):** *By Appointment Only*  
Services include assessments for medication, therapy, and diagnostic assessments for clients enrolled in services through Turning Point.

**Transition Age Youth (TAY)/Healthy Transition Initiative (HTI):** Services provided for youth, aged 16-25, with serious mental illness and/or emotional disturbance. Case management provided to support finding adequate housing, linkage to treatment providers, and building positive relationships with friends and family.

**Substance Use Program:** Serves adults with co-occurring disorders that meet ASAM Level 1 criteria. Group and individual treatment sessions available as an integrated component to a client's treatment plan.

This program is designed for adult participants with mental/behavioral health diagnoses to receive varying levels of case management that best serves their needs and goals. Maryland Medical Assistance is accepted.

**Mental Health Care Coordination (MHCC):**

This program supports children and youth between the ages of birth through 18. MHCC can be provided in the school and at home to incorporate a "team support system" for youth. Eligibility includes Maryland Medical Assistance and a verifiable mental health diagnosis.

This is a 1:1 program in which a peer advocate works with an individual to achieve life goals for a better life in as many domains of their lives as possible. One difficulty is that SDC's participants are virtually all living below the FPL(Federal Poverty Level) and face frequent challenges in maintaining stable life situations because of this. A mental health provider referral is necessary.

**Transition Age Youth:** The Transition Aged Youth Program is for those 18-25 with issues of behavioral health including substance use disorders. The program offers one-on-one peer support and advocacy services. A referral is not required. We are a voice for young adults. Please call us to set up a time to talk.

**DOGSNIP/CATSNIP:** DOGSnip has a \$40.00 co-pay for each dog spay or neuter surgery. CATSNIP has a \$20 co-pay per cat. To qualify, applicants must have an approval letter from appropriate government agency indicating receipt of public assistance, Social Security or disability benefits.

**SNAP (Spay Neuter Assistance Program):** SNAP provides discount vouchers and covers \$80 for a dog spay/neuter plus \$10 per animal for pain medication, \$60 for a female cat spay plus \$10 per animal for pain medication, \$30 for male cat neuter plus \$10 per animal for pain medication. All residents of Washington County qualify. Additional program requirements are proof of a current dog license and rabies vaccination.

**H.E.L.P:** For emergency situations the program can assist with veterinary costs, temporary boarding of pets, pet deposits, etc. (\$100 limit). Any Washington County resident who is currently experiencing a hardship due to the economic climate may qualify. Additional requirements are proof of financial hardship, such as unemployment benefits, proof of pending foreclosure, notice of bankruptcy, or workers' compensation benefits. This program is dependent upon available funding.

**Vaccine Vouchers:** Through this program, residents may have their dog or cat inoculated against easily transmitted diseases (Rabies and Bordetella) for free. This program is dependent upon available funding.

**Pet Food Bank:** The Pet Food Bank is available for anyone who needs emergency food. To receive food a person would need to walk into the shelter and speak to a Customer Service Representative. This program is also dependent upon available donations.
