# II. Background

The Board of Education recognizes One of the key components of a management system is the importance of strategic planning. The Board is committed to, in collaboration and partnership with the Superintendent and stakeholders, the goal setting should provide strategic planning, continuity of purpose, and stability of direction. success of each student through strategic planning and goal setting to ensure a high-quality instructional program, a positive and supportive environment for all, an engaged and informed community, and a responsible budget.

## III. Policy Statement/Procedures

A. The Board of Education will develop and implement a strategic plan in collaboration and cooperation with the Superintendent and will establish long- and short-range, well-defined goals and objectives that will reflect:

### Well defined goals are the basis for:

- good policymaking
- priority setting priorities
- the planning of programs planning, including budget implication consideration
- periodic evaluation
- effective communication and cooperation among bBoard of Education members, the Superintendent, administrators, teachers staff, students, patrons, and other citizens stakeholders
- accountability through periodic review and evaluation
- B. Long-range and short-range goals will be so designated with timelines.
- B. The Board of Education will conduct, at a minimum, an annual review of its strategic plan and make adjustments as needed.
