

APPLICATION PROCESS FOR SUBSTITUTE SCHOOL BUS DRIVER POSITION

- 1. APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:
 - \checkmark A high school diploma or GED is preferred.
 - \checkmark Must have a good driving record with no more than 2 current points on your license.
 - There can be no charges, probation before judgment or convictions for controlled substances, DUI, DWI for a minimum of the last 10 years.
 - ✓ Complete an acceptable criminal background check.
 - \checkmark Must be 21 years of age.
 - ✓ Receive a NEGATIVE controlled substances test.
 - ✓ Pass MVA physical exam for school bus drivers.
- Complete an on-line application by visiting wcpshr.com, click on Employment Opportunities. Fill out completely, with full addresses (street and zip code on reference section). Be accurate and complete. YOU MUST SELECT <u>SUBSTITUTE BUS DRIVER</u> AS THE POSITION.
- 3. If you do not have access to the internet, applications may also be completed in-person by going to the Center for Education Services at 10435 Downsville Pike, Hagerstown, MD 21741.
- 4. You will be required to supply three employment related references. These references must be from a current or previous employer. Please note that one reference must be from a past or a current supervisor, the other two must be from co-workers.
- 5. Once the application is reviewed, qualified candidates will receive a screening call for from the WCPS Transportation Department driver instructor.
- 6. If called for an interview, you are required to produce a complete, certified copy of your driving record from the MVA (\$12.00).
- 7. If you are a successful candidate, you will be required to attend a minimum of 5 days of classroom instruction, normally scheduled from 8:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
- 8. You must pass the written tests for a P, S, and airbrake endorsement to obtain a Learner's Permit (\$90.00).
- 9. You will then be scheduled for a minimum of 9 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction, depending upon the individual.
