OFFICERS OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

I. Purpose

Policy BCBB states the duties and responsibilities of the Board of Education's president and vice president.

II. Background

Each year at its reorganization meeting, the Board of Education has selected from its members an individual to serve as its president and an individual to serve as the vice president.

III. Policy Statement/Procures

1. President

- a. The Ppresident, except in cases when unable to attend, shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Education and shall have a vote on motions placed before the Board for action conduct the meetings in accordance with Board Policy BEDD and the Maryland Open Meetings Act.
- b. The Ppresident shall sign such documents on behalf of the Board of Education as may be required.
- c. The Ppresident shall represent the Board of Education in deliberations with other Boards of education, districts, organizations, or agencies unless another member of the Board is so designated.
- d. The president shall perform other duties as described in other Board of Education policy, the Board's Communication Processes, contracts, Memorandums of Understanding, and other such related documents.

2. Vice President

The \(\forall \) vice-\(\text{P}\) president shall perform all duties of the \(\text{P}\) president when acting in that capacity except as otherwise provided by law.
