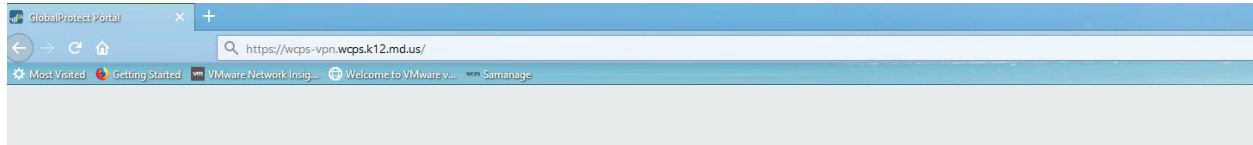

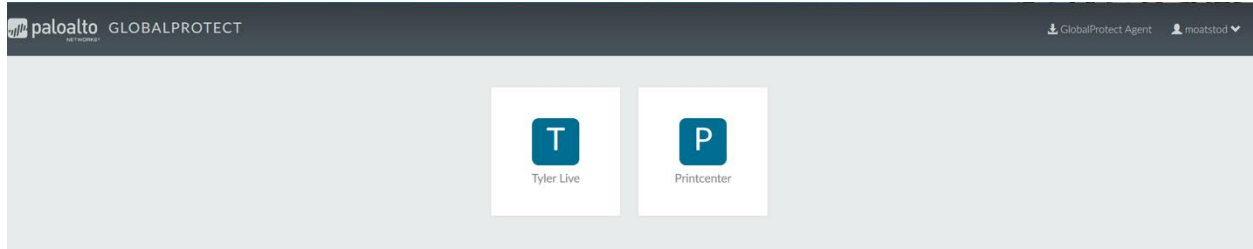
- Go to the following website wcps-vpn.wcps.k12.md.us



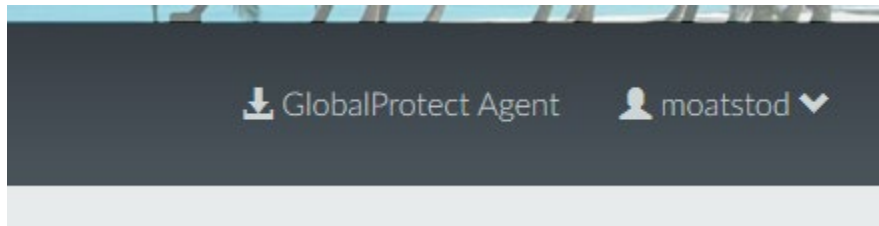
- Sign in with your 5+3 credentials

After you hit close a box will pop up in the lower right corner (see below).
