~~I. Purpose~~

~~The purpose of Policy IKFA is to set forth the procedures for veterans of World War II, the Korean Conflict, or the Vietnam Conflict to obtain a high school diploma.~~

~~II. Background~~

~~Many men and women during various conflicts in our nation's history left their place of schooling to serve their country. It is important that we honor the dedication of our veterans who left school to serve their country.~~

~~III. Policy Statement/Procedures~~

~~An individual who withdrew from a regular, full-time public high school in Washington County to enlist in the armed forces of the United States during World War II, the Korean Conflict, or the Vietnam conflict and was honorably discharged from the military service may apply to Washington County Public Schools to obtain a high school diploma.~~

~~An individual seeking a diploma must provide documentation that includes the record and date of the withdrawal and service discharge papers to the school system's Office of Secondary Education.~~

~~The Superintendent is authorized to promulgate an administrative regulation to implement this policy.~~
