- Appointment required; there is no requirement to be a patient. However, a completed registration form as well as a consent
  form at the time of the appointment is required. The forms are not required for each visit; but they are needed for the first
  immunization visit. Attached is the registration form in English and Spanish. The consent form is only in English. Both forms
  need to be completed, then schedule an appointment and bring immunization records to the appointment.

- For students currently enrolled or planning to enroll at SHHS or WHMS, free vaccines offered for students that meet eligibility criteria
- This is a school year resource with limited summer hours.

- Students will need to have a prescription from their primary care provider that clearly states what vaccine/immunization is needed. For those under 18 years of age, a parent/guardian must be present.
- Walk-ins are welcome.
