Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

WCPS is phasing out the use of paper interim reports and report cards. Since ParentVue allows parents access to up-to-date information regarding their child's current grades, interim reports and report cards, continuing to print over 20,000 report cards each grading period is unnecessary and wasteful.

To give parents adequate time to prepare for this change, we will send home report cards for the first marking period on November 6, 2015 and that will be our last mass printing of report cards. If you have not set up your ParentVue account to access your child's grades and progress, please contact your child's school for instructions on how to access and activate your account.

If you are unable to access your ParentVue account and would like to continue to receive paper copies of your child's interim reports and report cards, please contact the CSHS Counseling Center at 301.766.8085.

Interim reports for second marking period will be available on ParentVue on December 11, 2015. Please make sure you have activated your ParentVue account or requested a paper copy of your child's report card well before that time.
