



Pre-Kindergarten Skills to assist with Kindergarten Readiness



(This following list contains suggested items for Kindergarten readiness. Daily teacher instruction will go above and beyond this list as the students demonstrate mastery.)

Social Skills:

- Respecting people and property
- Managing and displaying appropriate emotions
- Working independently while demonstrating effort
- Following multi-step directions

Language Arts

- Recognizing first and last name
- Recognizing names of upper and lower case letters
- Demonstrating comprehension skills (Does he/she understand the story?)
- Communicating through writing and questioning
- Understanding concepts of print (First page of book, words go left to right, etc.)

Mathematics

- Recognizing numbers up to 10
- Counting numbers up to 20
- Describing and naming shapes
- Understanding more/less/longer/shorter, etc.
- Sorting and Classifying
- Demonstrating basic addition and subtraction



Science/Social Studies/Physical Well-Being

- Understanding rules and the need for them
- Participating in experiments (questioning/observing)
- Using large and small muscles
- Appropriately demonstrating self-care tasks (blowing nose, hand washing, clothing fasteners, general hygiene routines, etc.)
